Participants will have the chance to learn and apply workshop concepts to their own important work challenges.

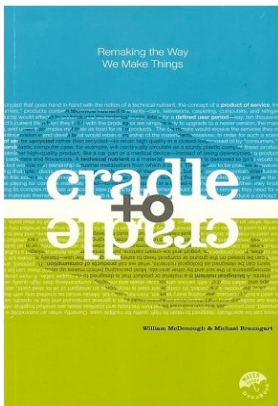
